## 9.2 Competition Rules (A-Class Division):

- Full WTF Rules.
- Competitors must be minimum 1<sup>st</sup> Dan/Poom grade.
- For the musical freestyle division judging will be strictly made in accordance to WTF rules on accuracy and presentation of the movements performed.

Mode: Competitors shall be allowed to participate in one or more divisions:  
(Individual Division, Team Division, Pair Division and / or Freestyle Musical Division)

Cut-Off System will be as follows:

- 1<sup>st</sup> Round: If there are over 18 competitors in a division then they will start in this round.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Round: The top 50% of the competitors (9-18 competitors) with the highest scores from the 1<sup>st</sup> round will qualify for this 2<sup>nd</sup> round (including competitors with equal scores) (possibility for extra rounds in case of equal scores to qualify for the finals)
- Final: The top 6 competitors (with the highest scores) from the 2<sup>nd</sup> round will qualify for this round. Divisions may start in the final if there are 8 entrants or less. 9 entrants or more will start in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Round.

**1<sup>st</sup> Round** – will be two poomsae from the 1<sup>st</sup> Compulsory section of the table.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Round** – will be two poomsae from the 2<sup>nd</sup> Compulsory section of the table.

**Final Round:** Two poomsae will be required and may be performed with a one minute rest period in between. The two poomsae for the final will be the two poomsae remaining in the 2<sup>nd</sup> compulsory section. All competitors must perform the set poomsae and if they cannot they will be disqualified.

**All poomsae shall be chosen, set and announced by the organising committee 3 days before the competition (Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> May 2009 at [www.utachampionships.co.uk](http://www.utachampionships.co.uk) and [www.utatkd.co.uk](http://www.utatkd.co.uk). We will also endeavour to email all participating teams and competitors.**

## 9.4 Judging:

Judges for each Division shall comprise where possible the highest qualified and experienced international and domestic judges available.

The scoring will be made by the judges showing separate Accuracy (out of five) then Presentation (out of five) scores. The recorder will combine both the Accuracy and the Presentation to give a total score for each of the judges.

The competitors overall score shall be made by removing the highest and lowest total scores and averaging the remaining three total scores.

The competitors with the highest combined average score of all the judges shall progress to the next round or be deemed the winner in event of the final.

In event of tied scores the competitors involved will perform further Poomsae (from either section not previously performed) until a winner is established.

## 10. B & C - CLASS DIVISIONS (KUP GRADES)

---

10.1 Competitors: The B-Class Division will comprise competitors 4<sup>th</sup> to 1<sup>st</sup> Kup whilst the C-Class Division will comprise competitors 5<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> Kup.

The categories within the two divisions will be as follows:

### Individual (Male/Female)

(Both B & C – Class Divisions will have 10 Categories each)

- **Peewee** (- 9 Years) Division
- **Cadet** (10 - 13 Years) Division
- **Junior** (14 - 17 Years) Division
- **Senior 1** (18 – 35 Years) Division
- **Senior 2** (36+ Years) Division

### Pair (1 Male & 1 Female)

(Both B & C – Class Divisions will have 2 Categories each)

- **1<sup>st</sup> Pair** (Up to 15 Years) Division
- **2<sup>nd</sup> Pair** (16 Years & Over) Division

### Team (3 members - same sex) (3 Male / 3 Female)

(Both B & C – Class Divisions will have 4 Categories each)

- **1<sup>st</sup> Team** (Up to 15 Years) Division
- **2<sup>nd</sup> Team** (16 Years & Over) Division

### Categories will not be combined

10.2 Mode: Competitors may enter more than one category (e.g. individual, pairs and team) but must all be from the same age group.

For B – Class competitors only Taeguk Poomsae from Sam (3) Jang to Pal (8) Jang may be performed, with competitors performing a different Poomsae in each round. The poomsae will be chosen by the competitor. One poomsae will be required in both the 1<sup>st</sup> round and semi-final with two different poomsae required in the final. Competitors may not repeat the same Poomsae and will be disqualified if any Poomsae are repeated (entrants therefore need 4 Poomsae).

C – Class Competitors may perform any Taeguk Poomsae from Il (1) Jang to Yuk (6) Jang and may repeat the Poomsae in both the semi-final and final rounds. Only one poomsae will be required in the final.

10.3 Judging: The B&C divisions shall utilise a similar WTF score system to the A class division. The differences shall be that for the individual categories, two competitors shall perform a single poomsae at the same time. Pair and team categories shall compete individually. All competitors shall be given a single combined score by the judges based on both accuracy and presentation. The B&C class divisions shall utilise the same cut off system as the A Class division.

The competitors with the highest combined average score of all the judges shall progress to the next round or be deemed the winner in event of the final.

In event that scores of tied scores the competitors involved may perform further Poomsae until a winner is established.

## 11. FURTHER INFORMATION

---

- 11.1 Awards: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place medals shall be awarded in each category. There shall also be 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place overall team trophies based on number of medals won by each team.
- 11.2 Dress Competitors may only compete wearing full WTF uniform. Jewellery is strictly not permitted.
- 11.3 Hall Rules: Only competitors and their coaches shall be admitted to the contest areas.
- 11.4 Spectators: Children (9 Years and Under) Admission Free  
Juniors & Adult (10 Years & Above) Admission £5.00
- 11.5 Guests Coaches/Competitors
- 1 coach per club/team (per 6 competitors) will have free admission
- Judges/Referees
- Invitations shall be made by the BTCB Poomsae Judges Co-ordinator to all judges who have passed the BTCB Poomsae Judges Course. Please contact us if you would be interested in judging at the event or would like more information on becoming a BTCB qualified judge.
  - All judges who participate will receive an allowance as well as full lunch and refreshments.
  - It is our request that all judges dress in appropriate attire (shirt and tie etc.) in accordance to BTCB / UTA regulations.
  - The organisers shall try to ensure that regular breaks and rotation of judges is provided for all judges and referees.
- 11.6 Protest Only the official head coach is allowed to protest to the Competition Director. This must be made within 10 minutes of the end of the contest. A protest fee of £75.00 will be payable immediately to the competition board. This will be refunded if the protest is accepted and won.
- 11.7 Liability All competitors are considered to participate at their own risk. Neither the organisers, the UTA or the BTCB shall accept any responsibility for any damages, injuries or losses sustained or incurred.
- 11.8 Additional Info Stanonbury Leisure Centre has a range of additional facilities including a 25m competition swimming pool available to all competitors who want to kick back and relax after the competition.

# BRITISH TAEKWONDO CONTROL BOARD

## PHOTOGRAPHY / VIDEO RECORDING REGISTRATION FORM
